The text should be typed in "Microsoft Word" (version 6 and above) with the following parameters: the size of the paper - A-4, paragraph - 1.25; field: top - 20 mm., Bottom - 20 mm., Left - 20 mm., right - 20 mm. Font Times New Roman. Font size 14. Line spacing - single. Alignment - the width.

Title of the article or thesis printed in capital letters, font 14, bold , without hyphenation , centered . The next line is skipped. Next 's initials and surname (in lowercase) , then without skipping a line - the full name of the organization, city (lowercase) . The next line is skipped. Following is the text of the article. Footnotes in the text in square brackets ([2 , p.15]), in the end - "Literature" in alphabetical order. The electronic version of the article and the application must be in separate files: one file - the author's name and the word "application", 2 file - name and the word "article".
